THE FOREST STROLL

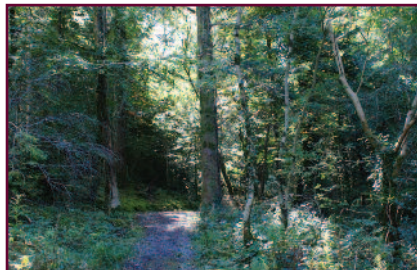
An easy stroll through a small woodland that is left to naturally regenerate. The forest is home to red squirrel, badger, fox and mink. There are beautiful mosses wild flowers. In spring a carpet of bluebells cover the forest floor. Keep an eye out for the unusual sculptures along the trail, created by local community groups.

Walk Directions:

A - B Leaving the car park at the rear, the route crosses the wooden footbridge, turn right onto the former railway line for ca. 50m.

B - C Taking a left into the trees and passing "the women" the trail continues for ca. 700m where it takes a sharp right emerging back on the old railway.

C - A Taking a right the stroll brings you back past B and onto the wooden footbridge. Crossing the bridge the trail ends back at the Termon Centre car park.
